SELECTING YOUR COURSES

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Here are some things to consider when choosing your courses:

SELECT YOUR LEVEL OF STUDY – depending on your GCSE qualifications you can study at either Level 3 (A Level & BTEC) or Level 2 (CTEC).

SELECT SUBJECTS YOU ENJOY – studying a subject you are genuinely interested in will greatly improve your chances of succeeding at college.

WHAT ARE YOUR PLANS FOR THE FUTURE? Whether you intend to go to university, on to an apprenticeship or straight into employment, different routes may require you to study specific courses at college – so make sure you do your research.

SEEK ADVICE – ask our careers team questions weekly via our purechatfacility on the website or discuss your choices with a member of staff at interview.

VISIT THE COLLEGE – attend open days, taster sessions and applicant days to meet subject teachers and current students.

A LEVEL

All A Level courses are two years in length and are mainly assessed via examinations.

To study an A Level course you will need a minimum of five GCSEs (with two at grade 6, and three at grade 4). Some courses will have additional individual requirements which can be found on the website.

BTEC LEVEL 3

BTECs are two years in length and are vocational in nature. This means they are more practical routes of academic study – ideal if you prefer assignments to exams.

To study a BTEC Level 3 course you will need a minimum of five GCSEs at grade 4. BTECs can also be studied alongside A Level courses if entry requirements are met.


ACCESS 2 A LEVELS

This is a one-year programme where students concentrate on one subject area either at GCSE or CTEC Level 2 alongside their GCSE Maths and/or English.

This is a full-time programme. You will preferably have a GCSE grade 3 in Maths and English for entry on to these courses.

Cadbury are proud to be one of the first colleges across Birmingham and the West Midlands with the approval to deliver to T-Levels from September 2021

What are T-Levels?

T Levels are brand new two-year technical course, offering an alternative study option to existing qualifications such as A Levels and Apprenticeships. Ideal for those students with a clear career focus in mind, they provide progression into both skilled and technical employment, or on to higher/degree apprenticeships and university.

T Levels will combine the career focus and practical elements of current technical and professional qualifications like BTECs and NVQs, with the theory and study of traditional A Levels. Developed with employers, they are designed to provide the skills and knowledge required to get into a technical career. T Levels will combine classroom study with on-the-job training as part of a substantial industry placement, lasting a minimum of 315 hours.
